She collaborated with Carolyn Balducci and Mira Spektor, Montauk residents, on their musical *Giovanni The Fearless* in performances in Montauk and New York.

After growing up in Montauk and attending school in Montauk and East Hampton, Lilah attended the Peabody Conservatory and the Manhattan School of Music. Lilah has also pursued a career as an educator and is excited to offer musical learning opportunities to the Montauk community. Lilah and her husband Milos collaborated with Ruth Widder on several performances for Music for Montauk over the years and are overjoyed to be carrying on the tradition and shaping new programming.
